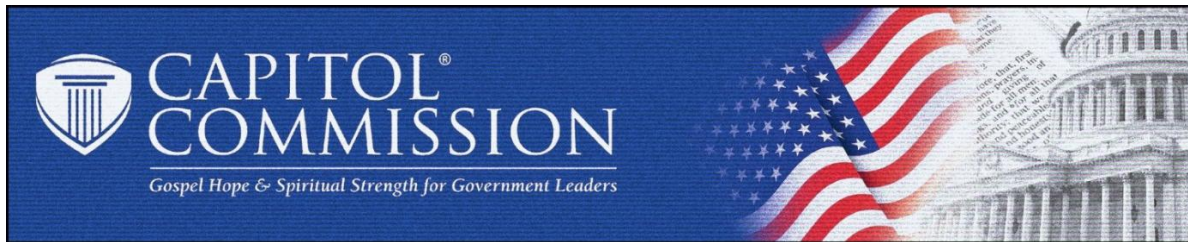


Subject: Update on Ministry to the Colorado Legislators and Staff


