



I thank God for you and your encouragement in this work. We taught about God’s leaders in our weekly Bible study. 35 legislators & staff participated. 500 copies of the lesson notes are personally delivered to offices. The notes are placed on the chamber desk of each senator & Representative.

I help by being present, meeting with them, occasionally opening the house and senate in prayer, coordinating the weekly prayer breakfast, bringing prayer requests to the prayer caucus and praying through their meetings. We seek God’s favor thru our text teams of prayer warriors and the small groups who send encouragement notes to our leaders. My wife, Joyce processes nearly 100 cards each month. I deliver these when they are in the Capitol, otherwise they are mailed.

Our hymn sing is during the noon hour every Friday in session. It’s on the 2nd floor, just off the rotunda. Representatives Webster Roth & Ron Bryce are featured pianists. Rep Emil Bergquist is our soloist. Back up artists are volunteers JuLee Adams, Jon Packard, & David Epps. The music “rocks” all 5 floors! Legislators, staff, prayer warriors, and capitol visitors drop in & out as their schedule provides.

Most saw the **planned demonstration by satanists** as a spiritual attack! I walked thru Capitol security and an officer shouted “We can all go home now. Pastor Dave is here!” The antidote was the prayers of two thousand filling nearby churches and worshipping on the Capitol grounds the evening prior and the hours of the protest. God was glorified. Kansas leaders covered the physical



threat by emptying the building and bringing in a couple hundred police and KHP officers. Only 22 satanic protesters showed up. Their leader was arrested after he punched a person who grabbed his list of curses.
